



Thoughts on Romans

<u>2:15</u> Which show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the meanwhile accusing or else excusing one another.

In the preceding verses the Apostle clearly explains that both Jewed "glory, honor, and peace" because of the Gospel of Christ (1:1 and Gentiles are equally guilty before God but have been offered 6; 2:11; 2:13-14).

Here Paul is further describing the condition of the Gentiles.

They are "a law unto themselves" (2:14). The Jews prided themselves in the Law of Moses, but that law could never save them and they never obeyed it. The Gentiles have developed their own "law" (various religions which are totally man-made and cannot save). The Jews ignored the Law of Moses; the Gentiles invented other things.

Virtually every man-made religion teaches that lying, stealing, and murder are wrong and should be punished in some way. Paul describes this as a partial agreement with certain aspects of the Law of Moses which is "written in their hearts."

This can be explained by the fact that God created man in His image (<u>Genesis 1:26-27</u>). Of course, all mankind is in sin because of the fall of Adam, but there is some awareness in the hearts of all that some things are wrong. This much is innate in the hearts of men.

Paul then speaks of the role of man's conscience (συνείδησις in Greek). What is the meaning of the word "conscience"? The word συνείδησις is a compound noun. The first part means "with, together"; the second part means "knowledge." An accurate definition of this word would be "an accumulation of knowledge about right and wrong."

All of us have been taught about right and wrong by quite a number of sources. Some of these would include parents, friends, teachers, pastors/religious leaders, radio, television, the internet, any number of things.

Some of these influences have been well-intended and are generally true and are worthy of consideration; others are obviously worldly/ungodly are should be shunned.

But all these things have been placed in our minds.

Unregenerate man naturally chooses the thoughts that either "accuses or else excuses one another." In other words, those who are unsaved either accuse believers of being "holier than thou" or "hypocrites" or simply ignore the Law's real intention.

What is the intention of the Law of Moses? Paul explained this to Timothy: Knowing this, that the Law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine (I Timothy 1:9-10).

Simply stated, the purpose of the Law is to expose man to his awful sin!


Why?

This leads men to repent "according to the glorious Gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust" (<u>I Timothy 1:11</u>).

Man must be convicted and condemned by the Law but saved by the Gospel!
